Board member of the International Rorschach Society (ISR) since 2002, including Vice-President 2008-2014 and President 2014-2021. President of the 2011 and Co-President of the 2022 ISR Congresses. Member of the Council of Administration of the Comprehensive System International Rorschach Association (CSIRA) since founder/director of the Asian-Pacific Center for Therapeutic Assessment in 2014. She is certified in Therapeutic Assessment with adults and couples. Member of the International Rorschach Institute (IRI) since 2020. Research topics: Normative data of children, adults, and elderly; hikikomori.
